Training aims

This course wants to train expert skilled workers, who will be able to imagine, design, develop, create and promote their production both in the fields of seat and setting.

Training duration

A two –year course (Level III)

Conditions of Registration

- Being graduated in a Level IV diploma linked with upholstery or any other Level IV Diploma (under conditions)
- Being under 26
- Admission is made conditional on the file committee's suggestion

Required qualities

- Patience, precision and a critical eye.
- Positivity is one of the key to success.
- Being a technical and experienced expert in the craft is fundamental.

Professional integration

- In Arts and crafts or as a “craftsman designer”
- In Small and Medium Business in a design department
- In a design office of big industrial companies / Creating seats prototypes in the industry
- Public premises or showrooms layout
- Performing art

Study pursuit

- Level IV or V Diploma in a secondary course
- DMSA or DSAA (Upper Diploma in Applied Art)

Weekly schedule

- 2 days of vocational teaching (16 hours) with introduction to seat carpentry
- CAD (Computer-Aided Design)
- A 6-week work placement at the end of first year
- 12 hours in Applied Art
- For better world perception and for erudition, general education is supplemented in French, Sciences, Foreign Languages and Management.

Conditions for graduation

- Each of the 8 existing teaching units must be validated to obtain certification.
- First year units must be validated to enter second year.

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
